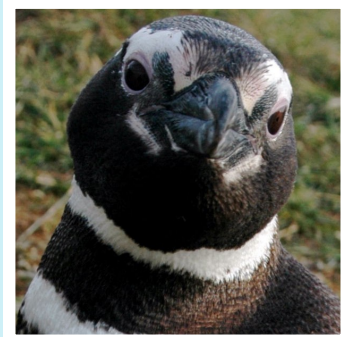

## THE ATLANTIC, TIERRA DEL FUEGO AND THE GLACIERS

**P**rofessional photographer Peter Boonisar and Latin America specialists Cabo Blanco Enterprises offer a 2016 photo tour of Argentina Patagonia, a land with some of the most spectacular landscapes in the Western Hemisphere. You'll visit the Argentinian steppes, the glaciers of the Andes Mountains, Tierra del Fuego, the Beagle Channel, and enjoy the tango and culture of Buenos Aires. Patagonia teems with an abundance and diversity of wildlife; species such as guanacos, maras, and Magellan penguins exist only in these remote areas. The colorful landscapes, deep blue ocean, Andean glaciers, and unique fauna of Patagonia promise spectacular photographic opportunities.

### THE TOUR INCLUDES VISITS TO:

- ▣ **Buenos Aires** – the districts of La Boca, San Telmo, Plaza de Mayo, Recoleta, Tigre, San Isidro, Teatro Colon, parks, plazas, local cafes, the Evita Museum and a tango show at Esquina Homero Manzi
- ▣ **Bahia Bustamonte** – a 200,000 acre “estancia” on the shoreline of the South Atlantic, a colorful earth scape with deep blue waters, sea lions, orcas, dolphins, guanacos, maras and Magellan penguins
- ▣ **Punto Tombo** – the most important breeding colony of Magellan penguins
- ▣ **Gaiman** – a typical Welsh settlement sprinkled with farms, chapels and Welch tea houses
- ▣ **Ushuaia** – Tierra del Fuego, the legendary island at the tip of South America, typifying the diverse ecosystems of Patagonia: South Atlantic coast, bushy steppe, Andes surrounded by glaciers, snow, lakes, forest, sub-Antarctic rainforest, and navigating the Beagle Channel where the Andes plunge into the sea to reappear in the Antarctic Peninsula
- ▣ **Tierra del Fuego National Park** – a seaside trek and canoeing on Lago Roca to view nature
- ▣ **Harberton Estancia and Gable Island** – navigating the Beagle Channel to Martillo Island and Gable Island for spectacular views over the Channel
- ▣ **El Chalten** – Los Glaciers National Park with views of the majestic Mount Fitz Roy, Mount Torre, the Viedma Glacier, and the icebergs of Lago Viedma – trekking through Rio Blanco glacier with option to hike to Fitz Roy base camp
- ▣ **El Calafate** – Cruising Lago Argentina through the Iceberg Channel surrounded by towering ice capped mountains and glowing ice-blue bergs, with views of the Spegazzini and Upsala Glaciers
- ▣ **Perito Moreno Glacier** - navigating the southern arm of Lago Rico along the entire front of the “living” glacier to witness gigantic blocks of ice crashing into the lake below

- Arrival and departure transfers to/from international and domestic flights
- Domestic air fare within Argentina (Buenos Aires - Comodoro Rivadavia, Trelew - Ushuaia, Ushuaia - El Calafate, El Calafate - Buenos Aires)
